

# **TENTATIVE Schedule:**

**Friday, March 31:** Travel from Jerusalem via the Allenby bridge to Jordan, visit the ruins of Sodom & Gomorrah, Mt. Nebo, and then drive to Wadi Musa (Petra)

\* check into hotel at Wadi Musa

Saturday, April 1: All day in Petra, many sites to visit, including Siq (the long entryway walk), Treasury, Byzantine Church, Monastery, High Place of Sacrifice, Theater, numerous tombs.

NOTE: Petra naturally includes moderate distance walking but some (optional) sites require hiking and climbing.

\* check into hotel at Wadi Rum

**Sunday, April 2:** Visit Bedouin camp and enjoy a 2-hour jeep ride through Wadi Rum desert scenery, return to Jerusalem, via the Allenby bridge
\* check back into hotel in Jerusalem

" check back into notel in Jerusalem

**Monday, April 3:** Travel to Tel Aviv airport, Leave for and Arrive home

The cost of the Petra extension is \$750 per person Double Occupancy (\$850 Single Occupancy). This includes lodging, three meals a day, entrance fees, ground transportation, and tour guide, and tips.

### **Jordan Weather:**

April weather is also ideal for visiting Jordan. The days are warm enough without being too hot and the nights are comfortable.

## **Travel Accessories:**

Bring sturdy but comfortable hiking footwear and comfortable hiking/walking clothes. Other items you will want for Petra and desert excursion: personal water bottle, sunscreen, hat/cap, sunglasses, and a light jacket for the cooler evenings.

### Jordanian Visa:

You need a Jordanian visa stamp in your passport prior to entry into Jordan. Thankfully, our Jerusalem tour agency partner provides these visas while we are in Israel. So there is no need to send your passport off to get a visa stamp prior to leaving for Israel.
