

Acts 13:16+ Paul's Speech: 6 groups of people, 8 characters, 3 symbols (Sabbath, tree, law)







What's In the Bible?

Words spoken or written from one person to another. Often rely on logic—moving from one idea to the next using words like *therefore* and *but*.

Words that draw a picture or image. Often with rhyming lines (English) or parallel lines (Bible)

Words that tell a story, Usually include a setting, characters, and plot (conflict, climax, resolution)

Why Stories?

Stories are the most universal form of communication

Whole Story in Covenants



"While a **contract** involves a <u>relationship</u> for the sake of **obligations**, a **covenant** involves <u>obligations</u> for the sake of a **relationship**. A covenant is a chosen relationship between two parties ordered according to specific promises."



Whole Story in Chairs

1 God created us in His image and wanted a face-to-face loving *relationship* with us

3 God repeatedly pursued **us** with his <u>Covenants</u>, Signs, and *Presence*:

- a) God saved Noah Stage, Rainbow
- b) **God** called **Abraham** <u>Seed</u>, Circumcision
- c) **God** called **Moses** <u>Standards</u>, Law, Burning bush, Mt. Sinai, Tabernacle
- d) God anointed David (and Solomon) - Sovereign, Crown, Temple
- e) God sent Prophets with warnings
- f) **God** brought us out of captivity and rebuilt the *Temple*

7 Jesus rose again and saves us - <u>New Covenant-</u> <u>Salvation</u>, *relationship* through the **Holy Spirit**, Bread and Cup 2 Adam and Eve turned their backs on God

(4) We repeatedly <u>turned our</u> <u>backs</u> on God after each pursuit from God:


- a) After **Noah** we <u>rebelled</u> Tower of Babel
- b) After **Abraham** we <u>forgot</u> God -Egypt, slavery
- c) After **Moses** we <u>wandered</u> -Wilderness
- d) After **David** and **Solomon**, we <u>split</u> the kingdom and <u>rejected</u> God
- e) After the **Prophets** we <u>ignored</u> his warnings captivity
- f) After the return from captivity we still didn't turn to God

6 We crucified Jesus 6 while the Father looks on and expresses His love and reconciliation through Jesus

8 The **Holy Spirit** lives in us and directs **us** to share the Good News of his love with others.



My Take-Aways

- Context—The Bible is the ultimate mega-epic a progression of epic stories (we need a whole story to provide context to all the other stories)
- > Jesus He is at the center, the focus and turning point
- > Presence/Oneness—God's purpose—He wants to be with us!
- Gospel—The story of Jesus as the culmination of the story of Bible/Israel (we need the Bible stories!)
