Prophet 1:

Prophet 2:

Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; the crooked places shall be made straight and the rough places smooth; the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; (Isaiah 40:3-5)

Prophet 3:

In days long ago, The LORD swore an oath to David, a sure oath that he will not revoke: One of your own descendants I will place on your throne. (Psalm 132: 11)

Prophet 1:

The words of the Lord to the prophet Jeremiah were written: In those days and at that time I will make a righteous Branch sprout from David's line; he will do what is just and right in the land. In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem will live in safety. This is the name by which He will be called: The LORD Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 33:15-16)

Prophet 2:

As it was foretold by Micah: But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times. (Micah 5:2)

Prophet 3:

It was written by the prophet Isaiah: A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. (Isaiah 11:1)

Prophet 1:

Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel. (Isaiah 7:14)

Prophet 2:

For unto us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
