Galilee, Perea (Jordan)
Executed John the Baptist

Archelaus

Judea, Samaria, Idumea
Replaced by Pilate

Herod Philip

(Did not rule)

Philip

Iturea (Syria)

Agrippa I

Executed James and imprisoned Peter

Herodias

Left Herod Philip to marry his half-brother.
John the Baptist rebuked this 2nd marriage

Grandchildren

Bernice

Left her husband, was with brother at Paul's trial before Festus

Agrippa II

Appointed by Festus to hear Paul's defense

Drusilla

Left her first husband to marry Roman governor Felix

Felix

Paul's first judge, left him in prison for two years until new procurator Festus became the second judge, and Paul appealed to Caesar

Salome

Requested the head of John the Baptist at the prompting of her mother.
