1st Journey	AD 48-49 — Acts 13:4 - 14:26
Antioch (Syria)	Barnabas and Saul (Paul)
Salamis	John Mark joins
Paphos	Saul called Paul, blinds magician Elymas, Proconsul believes
Perga	Paul & Barnabas proceed to mainland, John Mark returns to Jerusalem
Pisidian Antioch	Large crowds, jealous Jews reject, leaders drive them out
Iconium	Many Jews and Gentiles believe, city divides, flee plot to stone them
Lystra	Heals crippled man, crowds see them as Zeus & Hermes, Paul stoned
Derbe	Preaches, makes many disciples
Lystra	Return trip begins, encourages believers, appoints elders in churches
Iconium	Appoints elders
Pisidian Antioch	Appoints elders
Perga	Preaches

Jerusalem	Jerusalem Council AD 49 - Acts 15:1-35
